## **Dear Colleague**

Following on from our previous communications regarding the review and updating of the question bank, assessment strategy, centre compliance document and all associated documents, we felt it appropriate to bring your attention to other changes within the updated approach from HAUC TAG and all Awarding Organisations (AO's).

In addition to several meetings over the past year or so between HAUC and the AO's, we have also now created EQA Standardisation meetings which involve EQA representatives from all AO's and HAUC TAG.

The primary purpose of these Quarterly meetings is to ensure we have a standardised approach to the way we review and assess training centres, their facilities and capabilities to deliver Streetworks training in line with the assessment strategy and centre compliance document requirements.

These meetings have allowed us to approach the updating of all criteria and documents differently to how we have in the past and has ensured we have full agreement and alignment across all approved AO's within the UK, meaning all centres will have to adhere to the same levels of scrutiny and assessment regardless of which AO they are approved under.

These meetings are set to continue for the foreseeable future and will enable us to monitor and assess the changes once they go live next month and also to make any updates that may be required to ensure they remain current. All changes will be notified to centres appropriately.

As per our previous communication dated 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024, from the 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2025 all training centres will be expected to comply with the new requirements and will be subject to audit against those requirements from that date.

This should have been sent to you already but failing that reach out to your AO directly for a copy.
