Our Next Generation Higher National (NextGen: HN) qualifications:

- are adaptable and flexible to respond to the needs of a constantly changing employment environment
- support life-long learning and multiple career options
- integrate essential meta-skills transferable behaviours and abilities that help learners adapt and succeed in life, study and work
- develop critical industry and subject-specific technical skills


- HNC/Ds designed to be individual qualifications.
- To comprise of 120 SCQF credit points at Level 7 and 8 respectively.
- Larger and fewer units.
- Inclusion of a mandatory project-based unit worth at least 24 SCQF credit points (3 SQA credits).
- Reduction in assessment load.
- Mandatory Learning for Sustainability (LfS) outcome.
- Mandatory meta-skills outcome and incorporated in grading.
- New grading model and grading principles, no graded unit.
- New supportive approach to external quality assurance.
- Digital by design use of technology embedded to enhance and support assessment, learning and teaching approaches.

ESSENTIAL TRAINING

About NextGen: HN

Meta-skills

This 30-minute SQA Academy module provides information for practitioners about the inclusion of meta-skills within NextGen: HN modules.

Learning for Sustainability

This 25-minute SQA Academy module aims to develop a basic understanding of some of the key social, economic, and environmental challenges we face alongside the role of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals and Scotland's approach to LfS.

Assessment Support

This 15-minute SQA Academy module is the first in a series of Assessment Support modules and aims to give a good foundation in understanding of principles to apply in assessment design.

This introductory module revisits the fundamentals of assessment before asking you to consider opportunities for a combined and integrated approach. It may be of particular interest to those who are newer to assessment design and creation.
