

Many thanks for your prompt response. This is really helpful in understanding the reasons for sharing and the policies and procedures that you have put in place.

I have not been able to sign off an email to you with my DD today as she has been in back to back meetings. So I will send a formal one tomorrow.

Basically it is for the lead statistician (you I believe) to make decisions about the procedures around the release of regular and ad hoc statistics, including on content and timing. You need to be clear on the reasons for sharing this data and ensure that you have put in place the necessary principles and procedures to ensure the orderly release of statistics about qualifications 2021. Your email shows me that you have done this.

I will also point you to guidance that it appears you are already aware of.

I hope that will be helpful in reassuring people that the data can be provided. If not, please do come back to me.

The purpose of the sharing is to provide Scottish Government officials with an aggregated high-level view of the Provisional Results, to help with preparations for results day. Hypothetically, this could include for example, beginning to think about and make decisions around what support could be offered around University places for announcement on Results Day, etc.

So yes, the sharing will provide the aggregated numbers of grades received; but will also provide a high-level view of the what 2021 headline attainment is looking like, based on the Provisional Results.

The safeguards that we're putting in place include ensuring that everyone is clear about our 'Principles' and explicitly sign-up to them. (See attachments.)

In our view, ensuring that Scottish Government have early view of 2021 attainment is critically important.

Not only have the other nations done similar with their governments; but we were criticised last year in the "Rapid Review of National Qualifications Experience 2020" undertaken by Professor Priestley for not doing so. Professor Priestley noted that:

"Principles relating to what data is appropriate to be held by certain organisations at certain points in time.(i.e. SQA, the Scottish Government), which make perfect sense in normal times (e.g. arrangements around data sharing), appear to have impeded the development of actions that might have led to an earlier anticipation and mitigation of subsequent problems."

Yes, on 04th August 2021, you will be provided with pre-release access to the usual tables (by SCQF level, qualification and subject) and a separate publication 'Attainment by Sex Type, along with commentary, which will include visualisations.

We will we also provide pre-release access to the Equalities Monitoring Report (EMR), to which you would made a significant contribution. Note however, that the SIMD analyses in the EMR will be for Learners at all centres, not just Education Authority schools.

• As in previous years, local authority level data will not be published/available at this point but will be published, based on post appeals data, in February 2022?

Correct. Attainment data by individual Local Authority were previously published in April. However, we are planning to bring these forward to February, from hereon.

Note however, that the Centre Type publication in September (see bullet below), will show attainment for all Education Authority schools as a group, but not by individual Local Authority.

Results by centre type released in September 2021?

Correct. Target date is 21 September 2021. Commentary with appropriate visualisation will also accompany this publication.

- Post appeals data to be published in December as usual along with appeals report tables. Correct
- o Is there likely to be any indication of the numbers registering for appeals available in advance of results day? The deadline for self- registration for appeals is 12 August, and in fact, a teacher can register a pupil for an appeal up to 27th August 2021. Furthermore, registration for appeal doesn't guarantee that an appeal will be lodged. Therefore, I cannot commit to being able to provide anything definitive before September.
- Will anything separate be published once results for those taking advantage of the contingency arrangement for incomplete evidence are known or will this just be covered in the December release? The current plan is to include these in the December release unless the take-up is 'significant', or we find for some reason, that it would beneficial for users to publish something prior to December.

A couple of related questions:

- o Can you confirm / remind me whether cases making use of the contingency arrangement will be excluded entirely from the results day data or included as entries? They will be excluded entirely from the Results Day publications; but we are likely to include the number of entries registered for IEC in the notes. E.g., "Please note that x number of entries who registered for the Incomplete Evidence Contingency, are excluded from these statistics'.
- o Is there likely to be any indication of the numbers taking advantage of this available in advance of results day? Yes (providing the current deadline for registering for the Service doesn't shift)
- Anything else of note?

We are keen to maximise users' understanding of 2021 results, and therefore, we may come up with other ideas for things to publish externally. If that happens, I will let you know.

Hi Herb,

I will have another look at the Pre-release list when I am back in the office tomorrow morning and see whether there are any more names we can trim off. However, trying to significantly reduce numbers at this stage is really problematic.

In our previous discussion (see attached e-mail) I had indicated that I expected the number on the list to be similar to last year's original list – around 80 names. I said I would do my best to limit numbers and have managed to reduce them quite a bit – down to 59 names – but, as agreed, I did not attempt to meet any specific limit on numbers.

For last year's revised results we had 32 names on the PRA but this was only achievable because we didn't update the briefing for individual subjects when the results were revised – that's not the case this year.

As previously explained, our briefing covers individual subject areas such as Mathematics, English, STEM, Languages, Gaelic, Music etc. and it makes sense (and is, I think, in-keeping with the PRA Order) that the SG policy and Education Scotland experts on those individual areas are able to contribute to briefing and provide the best advice to Ministers. All of our planning has been taken forward on the basis that those who needed access would have it. To change that now would cause us significant problems.

I had understood, given my original request that it was "a". But I see SQA's Learner Guide states that "more than 140,000 young people across Scotland will receive the results for their Nationals, Highers, Advanced Highers, and a whole series of other courses, certificates, and awards" which makes me suspect the numbers you provided represent something else.

This is a crucial piece of information for presenting these data next week. So, I'd be grateful if you could urgently clarify:

i) What the 136,845 (and other figures) in the table below represents; and

ii) If the "more than 140,000" figure quoted is correct, then can you please clarify what that represents, and provide detailed figures afor this year and previous years so we can assess whether it is the biggest/a record etc.

Sorry to pursue this, but hopefully you ca see the importance/relevance. Cheers,

Hi Mick,

An accurate picture pre-2017 might be tricky. Too long a story to explain by email.

In short however, Operations colleagues who send out certificates do not keep a record (pre-2017) of certificates issued.

We, in Statistics, do not know how many certificates are issued.

But we can pull the number of unique SCNs attaining at least one A-C grade at an NQ level in given years, as held in our statistics database.

This may not match the number of certificates issued however, due to additional data cleansing undertaken each year on the data stored in the Statistics databases.

For example, repeat entries from a Learner are removed from the statistics database if that repeat entry receives a lower grade than attained previously by that learner. However, that Learner is likely to get a certificate, in any case. (Hence the potential mismatch.)

Let me know if you want us (Statistics) to pull the number of unique SCNs attaining A-C across all NQ for you? If, so I can get one of my guys to look into this on Monday.
