# Appeals 2022 Flowchart

Once you've received your results, if any of your grades don't seem right or you did not perform as well as your school, college or training provider expected, you may be able to appeal. Before you submit an appeal, you should discuss your decision with your teacher, lecturer or another member of staff. They will be able to advise you if an appeal is in your best interests. However, the final decision is yours.

Please note the following subjects are not eligible for appeal:

- National 5 Practical Electronics
- National 5 Practical Metalworking
- National 5 Practical Woodworking
