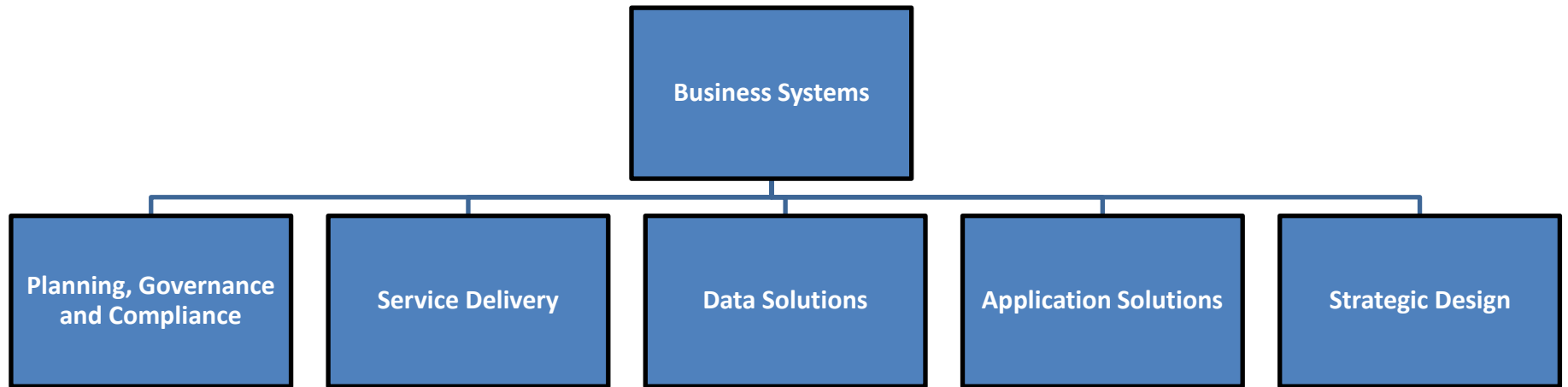

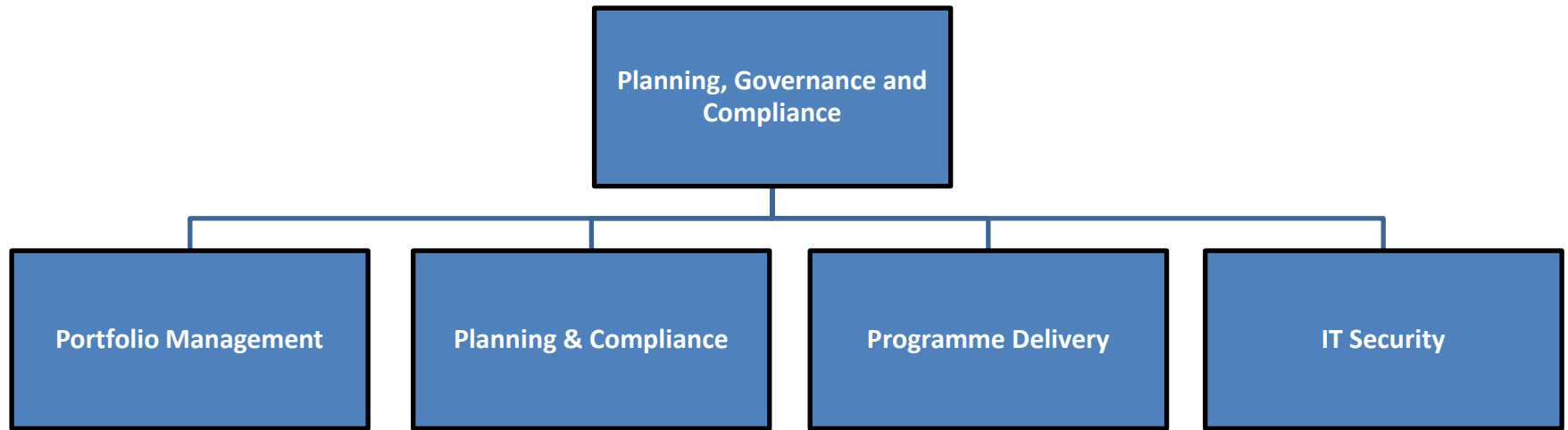
Business Systems Org Chart



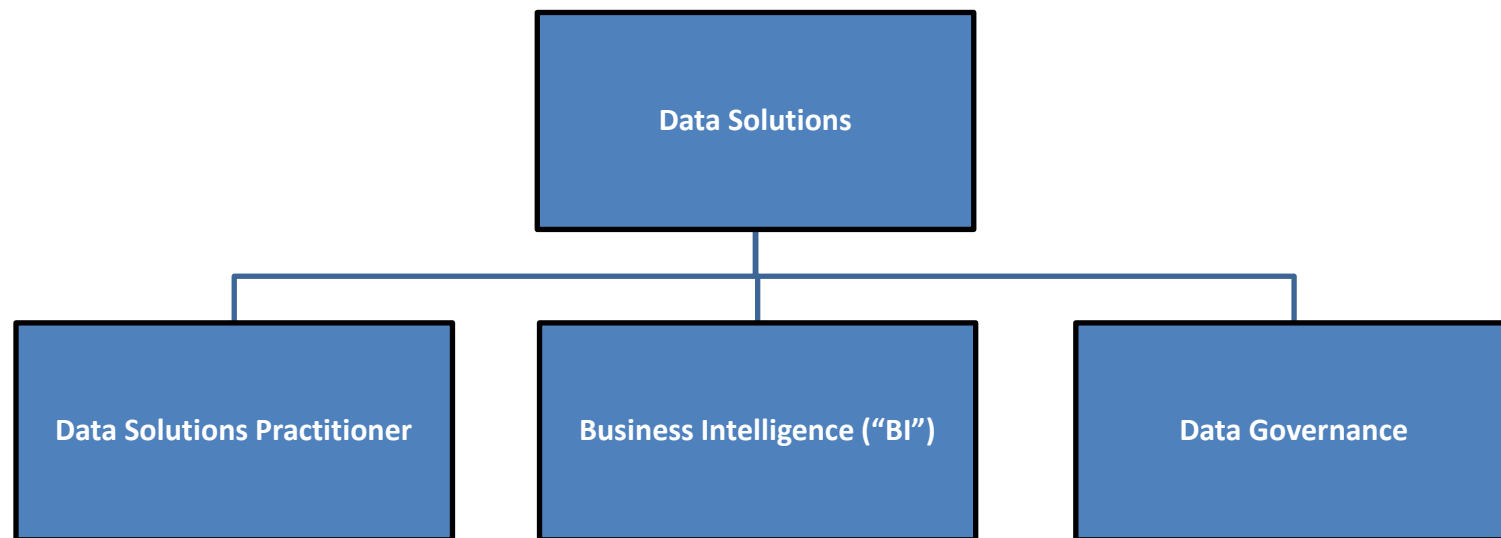

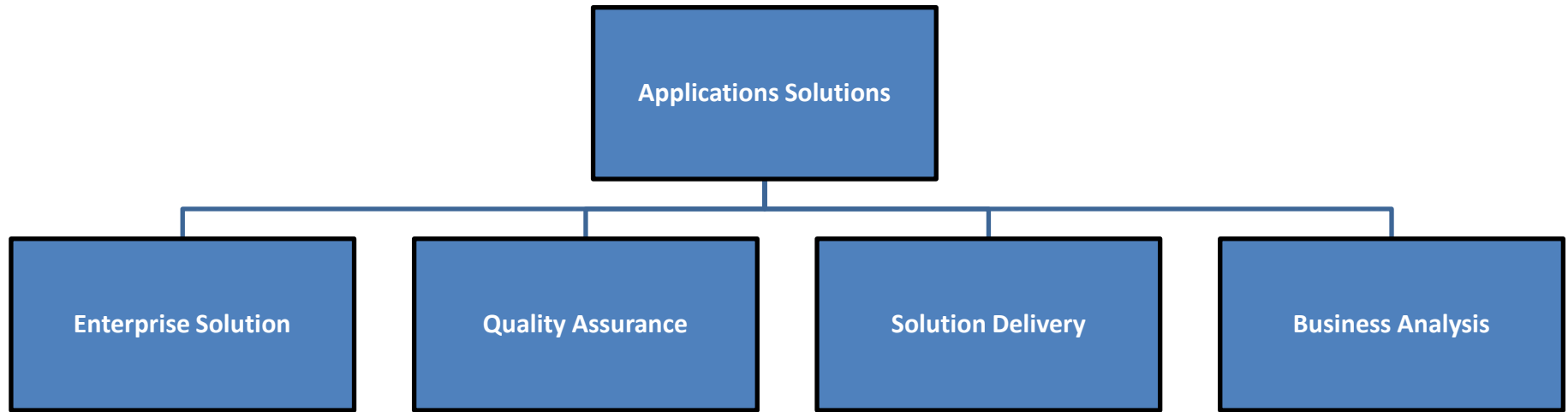
